ORDER

Before the Court is the Parties’ Joint Motion to Attend Settlement Hearing By Video, Or In The Alternative, Telephonically. [DE 261.] This is a securities fraud class action lawsuit in which the parties have reached a proposed settlement. The Final Fairness Hearing is scheduled for Thursday, September 3, at 1:00 p.m. CDT. The hearing was scheduled to take place in person, but as was discussed at the preliminary approval hearing, that was subject to change due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Based on the information provided by counsel in the Motion, the Court agrees that conducting the Final Fairness Hearing telephonically is prudent and reasonable under the circumstances.

ACCORDINGLY: The Parties’ Motion [DE 261] is GRANTED; the Final Fairness Hearing, scheduled for September 3, 2020 at 1:00 p.m. CDT, shall be conducted telephonically. **The parties, their attorneys, any objectors, members of the public or any other interested persons may dial into the conference by dialing 1-888-363-4749**

and entering 9147763 when prompted. All participants are strongly encouraged to dial into the conference line via landline telephone and not cellular phone in advance of the start of the hearing.

Furthermore, counsel for the Parties and their counsel are ORDERED:

- (1) To cause the settlement website (www.zimmerbiometsecuritieslitigation.com) to be updated with instructions on how to attend the telephonic hearing so that any interested settlement class members may call in;
- (2) To provide, via email, a list of names and affiliation of all known or expected attendees for the telephonic hearing to the Court's Case Administrator at Noel_Collins@innd.uscourts.gov and Simon_Chambers@innd.uscourts.gov no later than **1:00 p.m. CDT on September 2, 2020**; and
- (3) To call into the telephonic conference via landline, as opposed to from a cellular phone, in order to limit potential static and interference.
